All gate takings from MotorFest will go to the RACQ Helicopter Rescue Network, which provides life saving services throughout Queensland. The network includes RACQ CareFlight (Gold Coast and Toowoomba), RACQ Capricorn Rescue (Rockhampton), RACQ CQ Rescue (Mackay) and the latest addition, RACQ NQ Rescue (Mt Isa).

All four services are represented at MotorFest this year as part of the RACQ in the Community Display on the Ascot Lawn (near the Japanese vehicles). Come and see how the money raised at the event will help your local community helicopter save lives. And don't miss your chance to meet the pilots and check out the RACQ CareFlight and RACQ CQ Rescue helicopters, located on the track.
