

Renzo Piano • 155 Macquarie Street



Forming the residential part of Aurora Place, 155 Macquarie Street is frequently referred to as The Renzo Piano Building after its stellar Pritzker Prize winning Italian Architect. The scheme was a collaboration of the East Asia Group, Lend Lease and Mirvac. Once the site of the former nine storey Premiers wing that formed part of the NSW state office block complex, the residential tower is as innovative in appearance as its interiors are stylish and was built by Lend Lease and Civil and Civic being completed in 2000.

Each apartment is finished to the highest standard with the finest imported marble, stone and glass with only two apartments on each twin lift lobby. These stunning contemporary homes push the boundaries of innovative design incorporating louvered winter gardens, with automatic crystal shutters creating an endless feeling of light and openness, overlooking onto the world renowned Botanical Gardens with fabulous harbour views in the distance.
