

Bennelong Apartments • 1-3-5-7 Macquarie Street



Bennelong Apartments is one of the capitals most instantaneously recognisable developments, an ever-present in the international press scene with media outlets tending to lead features with pictures of Sydney Harbour with Bennelong in the back drop. Bennelong was developed by Colonial Peninsula, architects were a collaboration of Andrew Andersons and PTW Architects with the development being built by Multiplex and completed in 1999. Bennelong is made up of four separate buildings and is often referred to as "The Toaster" by residents, running the length of Circular Quay's eastern promenade. A feature of the development is the suspended bridge which incorporates a bar on level 10 and connects 1 and 3 Macquarie Street.

Apartments offer unparalleled vista views, those on the eastern side have views over the picturesque Royal Botanical Gardens whilst apartments on the western side have views of the iconic Harbour Bridge which must rank as one of the best in the world for those fortunate to own one.
