

Bridgeport • 38 Bridge Street



A conversion of the former Dalgety House built in 1966 the Bridgeport was originally commissioned by NZI Holdings and designed by company architects Terry W Petersen and Brink. It is an example of 1960's modern office design with clean lines featuring sandstone cladding. However the Bridgeport was converted in September 1998 into 157 residential apartments with three additional storeys added.

The building offers a mixture of studios, one, two and three bedrooms and is a combination of residential and serviced apartments. The service apartments are operated by AeA Hotels. The Bridgeport is an outstandingly maintained secure building with intercom access and security access to each floor.

Located on corner of Loftus and Bridge Street, just metres from Circular Quay, railway stations, ferries and ideally located in the prime financial district of Sydney's CBD and commercial buildings, it is the ideal choice of corporate accommodation / residence in Sydney for executives.
