

Broughton House • 181 Clarence Street



Broughton House is set within a National Trust Listed Building that was built circa 1900 and was extensively refurbished into 61 Residential apartments during 1980 at a cost of around \$4.5 million. Originally built as a warehouse in the late Victorian era, this powerful building features a magnificent foyer.

Despite refurbishment this building still maintains its soaring ceilings and stylish common areas with period features whilst creating a reputation for being an art deco style block. The building boasts an indoor heated swimming pool, spa and rooftop tennis court.

Broughton House is located on the corner of Clarence Street and King Street in the heart of Sydney's CBD and is within walking distance to Martin Place, Westfield Sydney, Queen Victoria Building and Town Hall and Wynyard Station.
