

Lumière • 101 Bathurst Street



An award winning vertical village which is now the centre piece of Town Hall Plaza, Lumière Residences is the iconic architectural design of Lord Norman Foster built above the Regent Place podium. The total estimated cost of the development was \$300 million. In 2008 Lumière won Urban Development Institute of Australia's award for Best High Density Housing in NSW.

The three storey glass atrium lobby is an architectural masterpiece within itself with the glass bottom swimming pool suspended over an elegant water feature. Whilst each apartment offers daylight, cross ventilation and dazzling views.

The 456 apartments are divided into three sections each offering different finishes. Lumière Blue situated on levels 15 to 34, Lumière Aqua situated on levels 35 to 44 and Lumière Azure situated on level 45 to 53. Level 54 to 56 then encompass the 3 and 4 bedroom three storey Lumière Sky Penthouses.
