

## Princeton • 304 - 308 Pitt Street



The Princeton was built on the site of a three storey building built circa 1900 which was mostly demolished circa 1992 with the exception of the façade that was retained.

The Princeton was completed in October 1995 and is a popular centrally located development around the corner from Town Hall.

The immediate area will benefit from the redevelopment of the former Water Board Building as the Greenland Tower (Sydney's Largest Residential Tower) helps transform this part of the city with a 5 Star Hotel and new shopping complex planned.
