

The Georgia • 155 Kent Street



The Georgia may not be the best known of Sydney's residential high rises but this is what makes this boutique prestige building a standout offering and perhaps another one of Sydney's hidden gems.

The development is built on a site of just 345 square metres making it one of the most slender residential towers in Australia. It was designed by renowned architect Ercole Palazzetti and completed by Multiplex in 1998.

The significant appeal comes in the form that each apartment in The Georgia encompasses an entire floor, typically 238 square metres. As you exit the lift you step into your own private lobby which opens into your luxurious home. This helps create a sense of elegance, privacy and tranquil living more in line with an intimate 5 star hotel.

All apartment offer dual panoramic views from east to west, with the Opera House and Harbour Bridge featuring prominently amongst the water vistas.
