

Observatory Tower • 168 Kent Street



When travelling south over the Harbour Bridge this much loved mighty landmark marks the gateway to the city. The Former 22 storey IBM Centre was completed in 1964 and it was sold for \$22 million in 1993.

Observatory Tower was born and in the process re-designed and extended, opening as a residential building with 198 apartments in 1996. During construction, the top level was removed and an additional eight levels were added; increasing the building height to include 29 levels of apartments and facilities, and the “west pod” was attached. The interiors of the tower were designed by Thomas Hamel and gave the building a very opulent feel with perhaps one of the grandest most majestic lobby entrances of any development in the city.

The building's unique colour and gold rooftop tower identify Observatory Tower as a prominent feature of the Sydney skyline and is one of Sydney's most prestigious apartment buildings.
