

The Peak • 2 Quay Street



In August 1994, ten levels of steel frame were demolished to make way for The Peak and Market City which were designed by architects Crone & Associates and completed in early 1997 by Grocon. The development was built over the heritage part where the historical façade has been retained that forms Paddy's Market.

The Peak is a 42-level residential tower comprising 370 apartments above Paddy's Market and Market City. The Peak project was originally designed as an office tower above an underground car park and a retail and entertainment podium. Construction actually began on the site in 1991 when it was decided to convert the development to a residential tower, including a shopping centre with a supermarket, specialty shops, a food court and a cinema complex on lower levels.
