

The Quay • 2 Phillip Street



Built in 1984 The Quay apartment block on Phillip Street was the first harbour front residential venture following the slump in the city office market in the early 1980s. Trustees Executors started the development but the project was taken over by John Lewis's Concrete Construction Company in 1983.

A highly coveted 29 storey 'trophy' building, The Quay forms part of the formidable "Dress Circle" of developments fortunate enough to have some of the best views in the world on the harbour front. It is also the home of one of Australia's most desirable penthouses, boasting uninterrupted views stretching from the Harbour all the way to the Blue Mountains. It is situated on the corner of Phillip Street and Albert Street and immediately across the road from Circular Quay and within walking distance to the Sydney Opera House not to mention on the doorstep of everything Sydney has to offer.
