

Victoria Tower • 197 - 199 Castlereagh Street



One of the very first high-rise residential tower developments to be launched in Sydney CBD during the early 1990's. Victoria Tower was developed by Leda Holdings and designed by architect Scott Carver and completed in 1995.

The development does not have any facilities within the complex which means lower strata fees compared with other city developments that offers a wonderfully convenient and affordable city address.

The residential development does benefit from being situated above a fully licensed club facility which is over four levels, formerly known as the Catholic Club but bought and developed by Leda.

Configurations;

- 39 Levels
- 252 Residential Apartments Combining a mix:
- 42 Studio Apartments
- 93 One Bedroom Apartments
- 6 Three Bedroom Penthouses

Facilities:

- 24 hour concierge - Ground floor lobby
- No facilities provided with the apartment however the Castlereagh Club is situated underneath the apartments offering leisure facilities.
