

World Tower • 91 Liverpool Street



In March 2000 Melbourne architects Nation Fender Katsalidis won a competition to design the building now known as World Tower which was developed and completed by Meriton (owned by Harry Triguboff) in 2004. The development was the 2004 Bronze recipient of the Emporis Skyscraper Award.

World Tower is for the time being Sydney's tallest residential building, a unique architectural expression with its glass exterior maximising views and light from each apartment, with many apartments encompassing enclosed wintergardens to serve as a study or addition entertaining space. Levels 18 to 75 are divided into three sections; Metro, Centra and Premier, a mixture of residential and serviced apartments. The pool and spa areas on levels 38 and 61 offer 180 degree views of Sydney.

Situated at the foot of World Tower is World Square, one of Sydney's major shopping complexes.
