

Finger Wharf • 6 Cowper Wharf Road



The wharf was built by the Sydney Harbour Trust between 1911 and 1915 and the structure is the longest timbered-piled wharf in the world, it is 400 metres long and 63 metres wide. The Wharf was rehabilitated after its abandonment in 1970's.

Finger Wharf was restored and completed in 1990; the redevelopment incorporates a hotel with 100 elegant rooms and 36 loft suites room hotel at the southern end and 345 luxury apartments at the northern end. It further boasts some superb restaurants including China Doll, retail stores and a 63-berth boating marina whilst large sections of the interior were left intact.

It offers a prestigious harbourside address, water and city skyline views and is a short stroll to the open spaces of the Botanical gardens.
