

North Apartments • 85 - 91 Goulburn Street



Built on the site of a two storey building that was demolished in 2001, North Apartments is Harry Seidler's acclaimed Sydney CBD development that was completed in mid-2003 which is a big hit with residents.

The building is orientated with a single façade to the North, facing Goulburn Street. Each of the 49 apartments features a wave shaped balcony and are arranged in a vertically staggered pattern so as to maximize the spatial feeling. Seidler also incorporated coloured toughened glass on the balconies end rails and dividing screens. There is also one commercial space and one retail space within the development.

The apartments are designed following a split-level planning system, which results in a ceiling height of 2.85m over the living area and 2.7m in the raised bedrooms. The raised bedrooms have no windows and open onto the lounge area.
