

The Horizon • 184 Forbes Street



Designed by the world renowned architect Harry Seidler The Horizon was constructed between 1990 and 1998 by the Melbourne based Grocon. It is an iconic Sydney residential high rise in Darlinghurst located between Liverpool and William Street, the building is a huge landmark in Sydney's skyline.

It has a distinctive scalloped façade and finished in rendered concrete. The design allowed for larger apartments in the top quarter, with balconies facing east towards the Pacific Ocean to maximize views. The location and shape of the building has also been chosen to benefit views of the Sydney Opera House and Harbour Bridge. The location of the balcony changes with each level as the view changes. It starts facing outward with the larger apartments on the top floors where the view of the Pacific Ocean is breathtaking.

Each apartment is divided equally into a living and bedroom space making it possible for the owner to interchange these two main spaces and add a little more creativity and personal touch. Two bedroom and three bedroom apartments and penthouses can be manipulated and re-designed.
