

Market Report

What a difference a fortnight makes.

Good rain across the eastern states has seen producer confidence grow and values increase significantly. Numbers are significantly reduced in all saleyards as producers now take advantage of the sudden flush of feed.

Tuesday's yarding, although only small, saw some good quality cattle on offer.

The yarding consisted of mainly re stocker cattle made up of yearling steers and store cows. Steer values increased by 20 to 35 cents compared to previous sales.

Cows suitable to the paddock saw rises of 15 to 35 cents topping at 266.2 cents per kg.
