

MARKET REPORT

Tuesday the 21st of February saw a very good line up of veal calves and excellent runs of grain assisted yearling cattle on offer at the Ray White Rural Prime Cattle Sale. Some very good well finished export steers and heifers were also penned for sale.

Although the recent few weeks have seen a slight easing in the market place across the country, this sale held up very well due mainly to the condition and presentation of all lines on offer with most lines selling only slightly easier to fully firm on the previous fortnight's sale.

Cows eased in value by 4 to 8 cents per kg with this being due mainly to quality.
