

## MARKET REPORT

Ray White Rural Kempsey's fortnightly Prime Cattle Sale saw 303 head penned for buyer competition. Some very good runs of early weaners and vealers made up the bulk of the yarding. Also on offer, some good quality feeder weight cattle with only a few well finished export weight cows on offer.

Most classes of cattle on offer sold to a slightly stronger market with the better end of the cows selling from 6 to 8 cents dearer on the previous market. The best autumn break for many years west of the Great Dividing Range is driving the restocker market with backgrounders and fatteners actively seeking most types of cattle to go onto winter forage oat crops. This break stands the producers of the coastal strip in a favourable position to take advantage of this present demand.
