

Market Report

Tuesday's market saw a reduced number yarded as producers ponder whether to hold off selling stock on a depressed market or gamble and wait for rain. As has been the trend in all market places over recent weeks, today's stock sold to an easier trend yet again. Most lines eased in value by 8 to 12 cents per kg with some veal calves, especially heifers easing by up to 20 cents per kilo on previous sales.

The yarding consisted of some very good weaners with excellent weight for age. Some very good export cows also made up a significant percentage of the yarding.

Most will argue that it's going to take significant rainfall event to stem the flow of numbers and significantly decrease availability of stock for sale. Hopefully this will see stability and increase in stock values and returns.
