

## MARKET REPORT

An Increased yarding of 224 cattle penned for sale on Tuesday the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August for Ray White Rural Kempsey's Prime Cattle Sale.

The yarding consisted of mainly weaner and vealer calves with some very good export cows also on offer. Most classes of cattle sold from fully firm to slightly easier trends.

With 75% of QLD and the majority of Western NSW desperately needing rain, the drying conditions are forcing large numbers of the market place. These numbers are forcing a downward trend in prices at present.

Quality females will again be in high demands when the season breaks as producers look to replenish their already depleted breeding herds.
