Easier across all lines is the only way to describe today's market at Ray White Rural of Kempsey sale.

As has been the trend of all sales over the past 2 weeks, nearly all classes of cattle eased in value by 5 to 12 cents per Kg.

Cattle showing effects of the wet conditions took the brunt of these value decreases.

Some good runs of late weaner steers and heifers as well as some well grown feeder steers made up the bulk of the yarding.

A few well finished cows were also penned for sale.
