

MARKET REPORT

For producers who braved the extreme weather conditions to yard cattle for sale, the effort was well worth it. Cows to slaughter as well as restocker cows sold from a firm to slightly dearer trend with the better export types reaching a top of 244.2. Cows to return to the paddock topped at 258.2 cents per kg.

Light and heavy veal calves made up the bulk of the yarding with some very well finished calves on offer. Heifers sold to a solid market with steer calves slightly easier.
