2019 Epic Dog Sale Terms & Conditions

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. By nominating a dog in the sale, I/we agree to be bound by any Rules, Regulations and Codes of Conduct as determined by the selling Agent, Ray White Rural Kempsey.
2. Ray White Rural Kempsey does not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury to dogs, handlers, beasts, ground, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever.
3. Dogs of any breed and age will be eligible for entry in the sale, the agent however has the right to reject or accept dogs on assessment of their working ability.
4. All entries are to be accompanied by a photo of the entered dog and video of the dog working stock for assessment and advertising purposes.
5. Entries must be completed by owners wishing to enter dogs in the *Ray White Rural Kempsey Epic Working Dog Sale*.
6. Commission on the sale price (6.6% including GST of the Sale Price) will be payable by the vendor to the Auctioneer in respect to each lot catalogued and sold. This commission is payable whether sold at Auction or private treaty.
7. Any person involved with handling dogs during the event within the perimeter of the grounds, does so at their own risk.
- 8. Sale Entry fee of \$100.00 + GST (\$110.00)**
- 9. There will be NO REFUND of entry fee unless accompanied by a Vet Certificate after cataloguing**
10. Entry fees are to be paid prior to the event with your nomination form either via Cheque, EFT or Eftpos
11. Handlers are required to work their dog on foot or Horse and each dog in the sale demonstration must be worked on stock.
12. The Abuse of Ray White Rural Kempsey Staff, other Vendors and cattle Donors will not be tolerated.

DEFINITIONS OF TERMINOLOGY GUIDE (For Catalogue Purposes)

Note:

These Definitions are to be used as a GUIDE ONLY.

Buyers must use their own judgement when considering their purchase.

Started

- Given basic commands, some training on a lead (Come, sit, stop etc)
- Keenness to work may override obedience.
- Rides on a vehicle or motorbike.
- Interested in stock and going around them in an enclosed area.
- Works according to natural ability.
- Handlers need to be on foot.
- Short practice sessions.

Well Started

- May be unsettled in strange places.
- Confident on a small mob and may not handle a large mob.
- Makes a few mistakes.
- Reasonably obedient depending on levels of desire.
- May need a while to settle when working.
- Brings a small mob of stock towards handler in easy situations.
- Learning to drive stock but sometimes goes to the head of the mob.
- Needs a firm hand and plenty of praise / encouragement.
- Can be worked from either a car, bike, horse or on foot when settled.

Trained

- Mature in appearance.
- May be unsettled in strange places.
- Shows confidence in approaching stock that it is familiar with (i.e.; paddock dog – in paddock, yard dog – in yards)
- Acceptable levels of obedience.
- Keenness to work and nature will depend on genetic makeup.
- Yard dogs are keen to either force & bark when required.
