Ray White Rural Sale Results

Due to the rain over the weekend in the local areas, this saw the market in high demand for feeder, light weaner steers & heifers. The high export cattle were similar to last week, seeing the price easing.

Ray White Rural Dalby yarded 374hd with a top pen of D/Master x Steers making 416.2c/kg head value of \$1303.69. Light feeder heifers sold for 386.2c/kg for \$100.26. A pen of Braham cross heifers weighing 266kg making 338c/kg for a dollar value of \$901.06. A run of 264 calves from Longreach, saw steer calves making \$665 and heifer calves making \$580, with the bobby calves topping at \$190.
