Ray White Rural Sale Results

This week in Dalby saw a smaller yarding of cattle 3060hd. The cattle market remained firm, seeing a strong demand for the little amount of top quality weaners available. The top pen of charbray cross cows made 287.2c/kg returning at \$1726.79. Heavy angus bull (785kg) sold for 293.2c/kg. Heavy heifers to processors made \$1671.66, for a cent per kilo of 301.2c/kg. A pen of 2-4 tooth heifer sold to a feedlot for 321.2c/kg weighing 440kg, for a dollar value of \$1413.28.
