

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

**WEDNESDAY 29TH JULY 2020**

## Ray White Rural Sale Results

With another small yarding this week of 2780hd and some rain over the weekend, saw the cattle market red hot and Southern buyers in full swing. Weaner steers & heifers in places were 10 to 20c/kg dearer than previous weeks. Export cattle sold at a similar rate to previous weeks. Ray White saw a pen of charolais cross weaner steers which sold for 420c/kg returning at \$1176.56. Their sister's also sold, making 384c/kg for a dollar value of \$1008.53. A pen of Brangus cows made 274c/kg for a \$1366.43 head value. Heavy charolais heifers (525kg) made 358c/kg returning at \$1880.55, feeder steers sold for \$1843.97 coming back at 380c/kg.
