Ray White Rural Sale Results

Yarding in Dalby reduced to a total of 2255hd. With local rainfall of 15 to 20mm saw the market remine VERY firm for light weaners through to heavy cows. Top pen of cows out of Taroom reached 304.2c/kg returning at \$1782.82. Heavy feeder steers sold to a dearer trend reaching 385c/kg. The Weaner market was on fire, with light angus steers making over 500c/kg. Weaner heifers sold to a similar market with the best heifers making 440c/kg to 450c/kg. Overall, all types of cattle were in high demand, due to lack of numbers.
