

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

**WEDNESDAY 19TH AUGUST 2020**

## Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers increased in Dalby today for a total of 3355hd. The market in the heavy export cattle eased due to a major buyer not attending, this saw the top pen of cows in the Ray White lineup reaching 280c/kg for \$2156.00. Heavy bullocks out of taroom made 306c/kg, very little heavy heifers to quote with the top making 310c/kg for \$1596.50. A run of heavy feeder steers topped at 388c/kg, with an average weight of 536kg. Weaners/light feeder heifers and steers were in high demand with strong competition. Weaner steers topped 472c/kg for a head value of \$1220.34. A run of 280 angus heifers sold for 446.2c/kg for the whole run, for a value average of \$1139.80.
