Ray White Rural Sale Results

Dalby saw an increase in the cattle numbers for a total of 3758. Ray White yarded 326hd. Roughly 1500 cattle were yarded in the first round. The absence of a major export buyer saw the export cattle sell to an easing market. Top cows in the Ray White lineup sold to a 278.2c/kg to value of \$1741.53. Heavy heifers made 320.0c/kg for \$1700.00. The weaner market was very firm if not dearer in places in the light yearling steers. Top weaner steers made 538c/kg. Yearling heifers reached 470c/kg.
