Ray White Rural Sale Results

There was a slight decrease in the numbers at the Dalby weekly cattle sale. 3428 cattle were yarded with all major buyers operating. The export cow market saw a 20 cent drop from the previous week with the top cows only reaching 300c/kg.

Heavy bulls and bullocks eased. Top bull 340c/kg, bullocks made up to 350c/kg.

Feeder steer/heifers saw an increase in 5c/kg. A pen of steers yarded by Ray White Rural reaching 402.2c/kg and returning \$1836.71. Weaners remained very firm with strong competition through the presence of southern orders. Top weaner lightweight steers reached 570c/kg and the heifers topped at 518c/kg
