Ray White Rural Sale Results

With a wide area of the Darling Downs receiving much needed rain over the last week the market remained firm across most descriptions however the market was reflective of the quality of the yarding. Cows remained strong for a top price of 324c/kg. Bullocks may have been 5c/kg better topping at 388c/kg. Bulls remained firm topping at 349.2c/kg. Trade weight feeder heifers saw an increase on average by 10c/kg Albeit top price remaining firm. Due to the quality yarding this week, Weaner steers decreased by 10-20c/kg for a top of 598c/kg. Weaner heifers remained in strong demand, topping at 528c/kg.
