Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers increased in Dalby for a total of 4431hd. This week saw the export Cows & Bull in high demand which reflected in the market to improve 5c/kg to 15c/kg in some areas. Top cows reached 330c/kg. Feeder bulls topped 388c/kg & heavy bulls at 360c/kg. The weaner market remained very firm with the good quality weaner in high demand by restockers following the recent rainfall. Heavy weaners steers(280kg-300kg) topped at 502c/kg, light steers made 570c/kg up to 610c/kg. A line of light Angus/Angus heifers reached 586.2c/kg
