### Ray White Rural Sale Results

This week in Dalby we saw the cattle number increase to 5380hd. There was a mix of cattle yarded with some coming from as far as South Australia, Birdville and all places in between. All markets remained very firm, with a large yarding of bulls. Feeder bulls topped at 398c/kg, heavy bull 350c/kg. Cows reached 340c/kg. A pen of milk tooth charolais heifers made 420c/kg weighing 421kg. All weaner descriptions sold to a very firm market. Good quality light steers making over 600c/kg.
