Ray White Rural Sale Results

A stronger yarding took place today compared to previous weeks with 4432 head yarded. All the major export buyers were in attendance as well as local restockers and feedlot buyers. Heavy bulls topped at 350c/kg, while feeder bulls made 602c/kg. Heavy cows averaged 299c/kg and reached a top of 320c/kg. Weaners were again in high demand from restockers, with steers making 712.2c/kg and heifers topping at 604c/kg. There was also a large yarding of cows and calves and PTIC heifers, with cows and calves topping at \$2750 and PTIC's making \$2200
