Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers decreased slightly this week with a total yarding of 4301 head. All the major export buyers were in attendance as well as local and interstate restockers and feedlot buyers. Prices remained firm for trade feeder cattle, with feeder steers making 470c/kg. Feeder heifers topped at 468c/kg. Feeder bulls reached a high of 414c/kg, while heavy bulls made 353c/kg. Cows overall came back an average of 10 cents, with heavy cows averaging 301c/kg and came to a top of 314c/kg. There was a reasonable selection of cows and calves, with a line of Hereford cross units reaching a top of \$3100.
