Ray White Rural Sale Results

There was very minimal change in numbers yarded today compared to last sale, with a total of 4291 head sold. All the major export buyers were in attendance as well as local and interstate restockers and feedlot buyers. Cows came back an average of 5 cents, with heavy cows averaging 295c/kg and came to a top of 306c/kg. Prices again remained firm for trade feeder cattle, with quality the only factor holding back a portion of what was on offer. Feeder heifers made 472c/kg, while feeder steers topped at 542c/kg. Feeder bulls reached a high of 406c/kg, while heavy bulls made 343c/kg. There was a good selection of cows and calves, with a pen of first calf heifers with calves at foot making of \$2925.
