WEDNESDAY 24th February 2021

Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers were down slightly today compared to last sale, with a total of 4093 head yarded. All the major export buyers were in attendance as well as local and interstate restockers and feedlot buyers. Today saw an overall good yarding of cattle from export cows to good quality lightweight weaners. Heavy bulls made 330c/kg. Heavy cows received good competition from a number of export buyers which saw prices remain firm, with heavy cows averaging 292.9c/kg and came to a top of 314c/kg. Store cows were in demand, with young store cows making 320c/kg. Prices again remained firm for trade feeder cattle, with a good quality yarding overall. Feeder heifers made 458c/kg, while feeder steers topped at 470c/kg. There was a solid yarding of light weaners today, with the majority being from 150-220kg. A pen of lightweight Angus steers topped at 670c/kg, while heifers came to a high of 584c/kg.
