Ray White Rural Sale Results

This week saw the cattle number remain very similar to the previous weeks with a total yard of 4145hd. Overall there was a smaller yard of export cattle, with the 1st round cattle, saw the fat cow market ease compared to previous weeks. Top cows reaching 314c/kg. Heavy bulls reached 315c/kg, light feeder bulls 398c/kg. Strong competition in the feeder steer market saw a pen of steer reaching 449.2kc/kg. Lightweight weaner cattle remained solid with quality the only factor hindering prices. Lightweight steers reached 660c/kg to average 520c/kg. Weaner EU Santa heifers topped at 480c/kg to return at \$1380/hd. There was a large yarding of Cows and Calves making from \$1400 to \$2700.
