

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

## WEDNESDAY 10<sup>th</sup> March 2021

### Ray White Rural Sale Results

This week's sale saw numbers decrease by 752 to 3393 head. The majority of export and feedlot buyers were in attendance, as well as local and interstate restockers. Overall prices for heavy cattle came back slightly, with Heavy Cows reaching 308c/kg.

Heavy bulls reached 316c/kg, while light Feeder Bulls came to a top of 412c/kg. Feeder steers were again sought after, reaching a top of 440c/kg. Lightweight weaner cattle remained solid with quality the only factor hindering prices. Lightweight Steers reached 670c/kg to average 513.7c/kg and Heifers topped at 616c/kg to average 464.6c/kg. There was a small selection of Cows and Calves yarded, with the top unit making \$2940.
