Ray White Rural Sale Results

Over the last 3 days the local Darling Downs area has seen impressive rainfall, with good falls from around 50 to 100mls. This saw numbers decrease for a total of 1983hd. The smaller yarding saw very limited numbers in most areas from export cattle to light weight weaners. Top heavy cows reached 306c/kg. Feeder steers, 2 lines of Santa/Droughtmaster & Charbray/Braham cross steers sold to a top of 438c/kg and averaged 420c/kg. Weaners increased on average from the muchly needed rain. Light steers reached 726c/kg and a line of Speckle Park heifers made 670c/kg. Cows & Calves topped at \$2900.
