

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

## WEDNESDAY 24<sup>th</sup> March 2021

### Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers were back 778hd from the previous week due to welcome widespread rain across South-Eastern parts of the state, with a total of 1205hd of cattle being sold. Prices improved across most areas, with light weight cattle returning to the paddock being in high demand yet again. The top of the heavy cows reached 329.2c/kg to average 306c/kg. Feeder steers made up to 444c/kg and averaged 423c/kg. Lightweight weaners were again highly sought after by restockers. Light steers reached 700c/kg to average 575c/kg, while heifers made 625c/kg.
