

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

WEDNESDAY 31st March 2021

Ray White Rural Sale Results

A total of 1698hd of cattle were sold today at the Dalby saleyards, with numbers still back due to recent rain. The Cow market fell up to 28c/kg, with the majority selling for 20c/kg cheaper compared to the last sale. Good quality heavy cows made up to 285c/kg to average 269c/kg. Heavy weight feeder cattle improved by 10c/kg average, with heavy feeder steers made up to 464c/kg and averaged 435c/kg. Lightweight weaners were again highly sought after by local and interstate restockers which helped retain the high prices seen in previous weeks. Light steers reached 694c/kg to average 562c/kg, while heifers came to a top of 586c/kg.
