Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers were back again compared to previous weeks due to more rainfall in South Eastern Queensland, bringing the total yarding to 1040hd. Heavy cows finished up 8c/kg to 34c/kg stronger this week due to strong competition from the buying panel. Good quality heavy cows made up to 317c/kg to average 312c/kg. Heavy feeders sold to a slightly dearer trend, with heavy feeder steers making up to 470c/kg and averaging 452c/kg. Lightweight weaners were again highly sought after, with light steers under 200kg reaching 696c/kg to average 656c/kg, while heifers came to a top of 620c/kg. A pen of PTIC Cows with calves at foot made \$3190.
