WEDNESDAY 14th April 2021

Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers were back up to 4195 head today in Dalby, which drew a good panel of feedlot and export buyers as well as local and interstate restockers. A larger supply of good quality heavy weight cows saw the average price fall around 8c/kg from last week, with them topping at 310c/kg. Heavy feeders remained reasonably unchanged from last week, with heavy feeder steers making up to 474c/kg and averaging 436c/kg. Lightweight yearling steers improved by 18c/kg, topping at 670.2c/kg to average 583c/kg. Heifers came to a top of 606c/kg and averaged 526c/kg. There was a large selection of Cows and Calves today, with the top pen making \$2680.
