Ray White Rural Sale Results

As another wet day comes to an end at the Dalby saleyards, numbers reduced to 2320hd. A large panel of buyers were in attendance, along with local restockers due to the rain about. All markets improved with the light weaners showing the biggest jump with strong competition. Heavy cows topped at 314c/kg. Meatworks bulls improved 5c/kg to reach a high of 325c/kg. Feeders were strong for the cross bred to top at 428c/kg and angus feeders made 490c/kg. With a large number of local restockers in attendance, this saw the light weaners topping at 700c/kg for steers and the heifers reached a top of 580c/kg.
