Ray White Rural Sale Results

This week's Dalby Cattle Sale saw a small increase in numbers with a total yarding of 2840hd. Overall the yarding quality was very mixed right through from store PTIC cows to fat cattle. The Market was very strong and improved over most descriptions, with the biggest increase seen in the light weight weaner steers, improving 5-15c/kg in places. Top export cows reached 319c/kg with PTIC cows selling for a top of 356c/kg.

Heavy bulls topped at 340c/kg, light weaner steers sold for a top of 728c/kg and weaner heifers reached 710c/kg.
