Ray White Rural Sale Results

Cattle numbers increased for a total of 3445 head. This week saw a major export buyer not present today along with the talk of the possibility of the export market erasing, however the market still held very firm across the board. Top heavy cows reached 313c/kg. Store cows were in high demand with a strong panel of new buyers. Best pen of store cows topped at 335c/kg. The feeder market remained firm and light weaners sold to a strong market. Weaner steers returned to the paddock topping at 665c/kg.
