Ray White Rural Sale Results

With a cold, wet day in Dalby we saw cattle numbers decrease for a total of 2258hd. A number of heavy feeder steers were on offer, with angus feeders reaching 498c/kg and flat back crossbred steers topping at 445c/kg. Limited cows yarded today with still a major export buyer NOT in attendance. Heavy cows reached 308c/kg and PTIC /Store cows were in high demand selling for a top of 358c/kg. Weaners are showing great weight for this time of the year and sold to a strong market.
