Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers slightly increased for a total of 2957hd yarded today. The export market started off a lot cheaper than previous weeks but did improve as the day went on.

Overall, the top pen of cows reached 310c/kg with PTIC cows reaching 438c/kg. Heavy bulls sold to a cheaper trend erasing by 15 to 20c/kg with heavy bulls topping at 315c/kg. The feeder and weaner market was very strong with many people spending up with the end of the financial year approaching. Feeder angus steers reached 550c/kg, and a line of quality charolais cross weaners made 628c/kg.
